Dear Colleagues,

As you are aware, the 2nd Rajaswa Gyan Sangam is scheduled for 1st and 2nd September, 2017. Also for those tax payers who want to fill up TRAN-I this month, the last date for filing GSTR-3B is 28th August, 2017. In order to avoid any difficulty to the taxpayer, kindly guide the taxpayers of your Zone to make payment and fill return well before the deadlines. The letter issued by Member (GST) on 22nd August, 2017 may kindly be seen and adhered to.


